## 3 Purposes

- 1. Prepare the audience for your selection
- 2. Prepares you to perform
- 3. Let's the audience see who you are as a person, not a performer

The introduction is just as important as the teaser.

The introduction is 4-5 sentences

- Broad theme quotation one sentence that states theme.
  - Narrow theme to audience
     1 or 2 sentences.
    - 3. Apply theme to the story 1 sentence.
      - 4. Title, Author

Don't go into performance mode! Be you! Less than I minute, memorized, but sound conversational.

Keep it short.
Set the mood.
Perform with script closed.
